**DIRECTIONS:** Int. 84 Exit 67. Go south on Rte. 31 for 2 miles to top of the hill. Turn right onto Dockerel Rd., follow to end. Turn left onto Hatch Hill Rd. Proceed a short distance, turn right onto Grier Rd. Go about 2 miles, past Camp Newhoca sign, watch for ISCCC sign on right.

From eastern CT: Rte. 6 to Rte. 44 to Rte. 31 north to Coventry. Continue ¾ mi., turn left onto Dockerel Rd. and follow above directions.
